FINISH IN SIGHT

The finish line is in sight.

Improvements to Trinity's sanctuary are racing down the home stretch.

The results won't disappoint.

Since Oct. 14-15, when Trinity moved its worship services to the Fellowship Hall, new paint, flooring and windows have been installed in the sanctuary.

DETAILS

The new pews arrived this past week, and installation has begun - an installation crew has been working 16-hour days.

The cross that hangs behind the altar has been refurbished and is scheduled to be hung this week.

New exit lights, along with can and flood lights have been installed.

There's still some work left - installation of the narthex flooring and replacing the doors that lead into the sanctuary.

Trinity still is on track for a mid-February re-entry into the sanctuary – a weekend celebration, which will be centered around the Divine Service and will include hymns and homilies, is in the works.

Beyond the sanctuary, improvements to Trinity's gym and the installation of windows in the north wing classrooms are scheduled to begin this spring.

We keep pushing forward, walking by faith and trusting in Him.
