"We must learn to regard people less in the light of what they do or omit to do, and more in the light of what they suffer," shared Dietrich Bonhoeffer, a German Lutheran theologian.

The Bible is filled with compassionate hearts, including Ruth, the widow of Zarephath, Moses, Joseph, Paul, Barnabas, the Good Samaritan.

"All of these struggles silence people, and they need to know that they are loved and forgiven by our Lord."
