PARKING LOT TRAFFIC FLOW UPDATE

To ensure safety, and because of construction, all vehicles leaving Trinity's main parking lot onto Central Park will only be able to turn right. Vehicles then can turn left onto Lillie Street to avoid construction at the intersection of Central Park and Marquette Street. Vehicles still will be able to enter Trinity's main parking lot off Central Park. Just a reminder that northbound Marquette Street is detoured at Lombard, and southbound Marquette Street is open through the intersection. The City of Davenport is hopeful that the intersection at Central Park and Marquette Street will be open to traffic – in all directions - in three to four weeks.

NEW SECURITY MEASURE

Trinity has increased its security presence – with the help of a state-wide grant - with the use of the Raptor Emergency Management system. The system allows Trinity to communicate emergencies within the building and manage visitors in the building. Visitors coming to the building during the school day will need to have their ID (driver's license or state ID) scanned before gaining access to the building (beyond the vestibule). The scanning system also will do a background check and print out a sticker for the visitor to wear while in the building. Trinity appreciates your patience as we move forward with this new system.
